Every detail matters and that starts with the exact time and location of your accident. This information can be found near the top of Page 1. Make sure this information is accurate. If not, insurance companies could deny your claim on a technicality.

Driver Information

Here again, details matter. Make sure the police officer investigating your crash got the correct names and addresses of all the drivers. Seemingly minor details like the "estimated speed" of the car at the time of the accident can also be critical pieces of evidence. If the other driver was driving too fast, speed may have been a factor in your accident.
